(S) [REDACTED], a Seattle Seahawks fan, was interviewed on October 14, 2013, at a secure location at the FBI Field Office in Seattle, Washington. [REDACTED] provided the following information:

(S) [REDACTED] attended the October 13, 2013 contest between the Seattle Seahawks and the Tennessee Titans at CenturyLink Field in Seattle, Washington.

(S) In the first quarter of play, [REDACTED] took a series of photographs of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] as he made an interception.

(S) [REDACTED] said that during the game, he was stunned at how quickly [REDACTED] had made the interception, but had become accustomed to [REDACTED] blinding speed since entering the league.

(S) Later that night, however, [REDACTED] made a discovery while reviewing photographs he had taken from the stands during the game. In particular, a three-photo sequence of the interception was shocking. [REDACTED] was nowhere to be found in the first photograph. In the second picture, while other players have moved scarcely more than few feet, [REDACTED] had covered 10-15 yards and is about to intercept the ball. By the third photo, he has completed the play.

(S) All three photos were reviewed by FBI photographic experts and were confirmed as authentic, manipulation free originals.

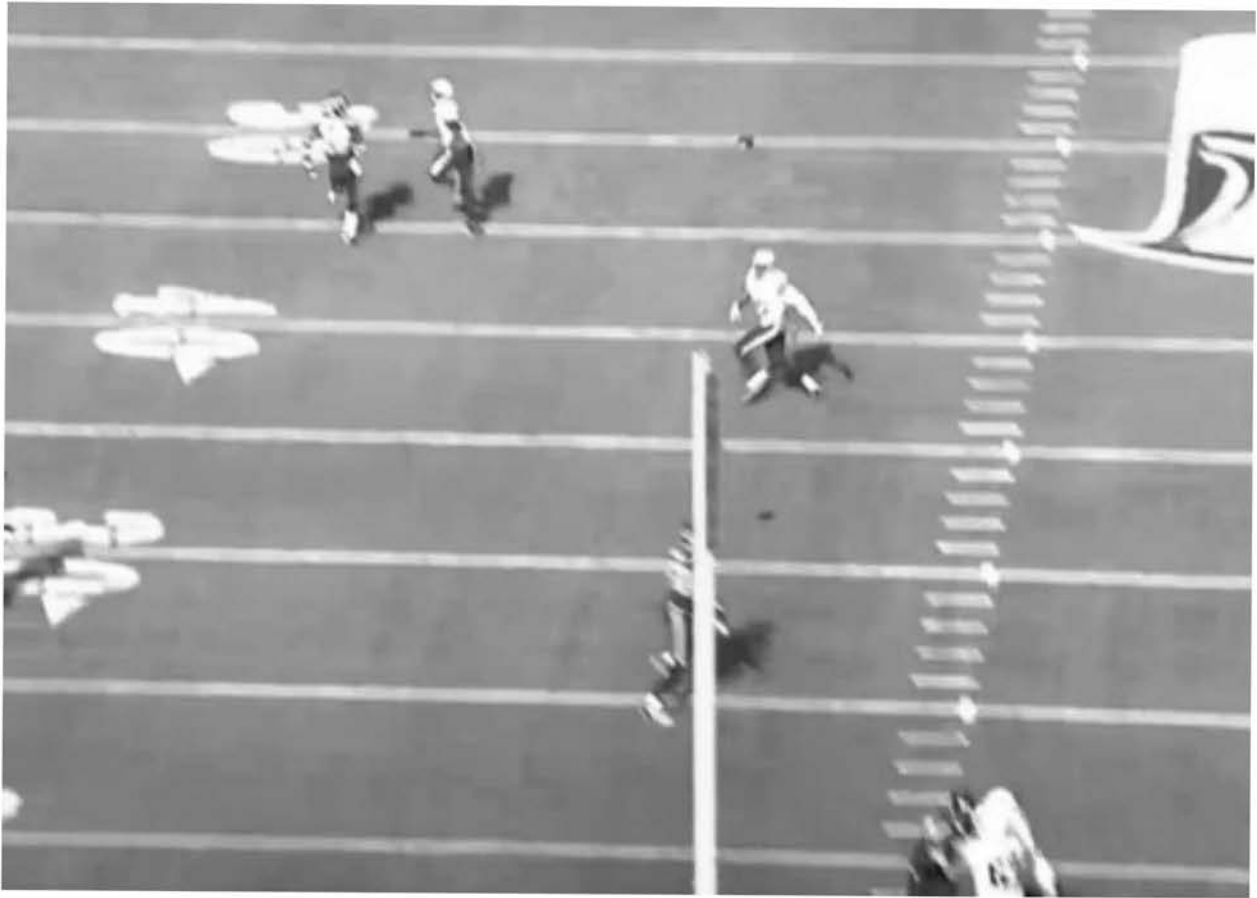
